**Requirements for the Transition from LPN to A.A.S. RN Program**

The transition from LPN to the A.A.S. RN Program is another career option for Licensed Practical Nurses. The transition course is open to any Licensed Practical Nurse who fulfills the following criteria:

1. Successful completion of an accredited practical nursing program \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)
2. Passed the NCLEX-PN Examination \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)
3. Completed MAT 105 and CHE 105 \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)
4. Passed the NLN Mobility I Profile Examination prior to NUR 200 \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)
5. Have a GPA of at least 2.5 to enter and progress through the nursing program \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)
6. Completion of all RN pre-requisites \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)
7. Passed the Reading, Writing and Math examinations \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)
8. Have passed the MATH – examination and placed in MAT 105 \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)
9. COMPLETION of Nurse Transitions course – NUR 200 \_\_\_\_\_(Y/N)

Note: If not a graduate of Hostos' Certificate Program in Licensed Practical Nursing or a CUNY certificate-bearing Practical Nursing Program, the candidate must meet the entrance requirements as outlined in the Student Handbook
