The Behavioral and Social Sciences Department at Hostos Community College invites applications for a full-time Lecturer position in Economics commencing August 31, 2018. The successful candidate will teach undergraduate courses in Microeconomics and Macroeconomics, provide service to the department and college, and engage in professional development, student advisement, assessment and curriculum innovation.

Located in the South Bronx, Hostos is part of the City University of New York (CUNY) and is recognized as a Hispanic Serving Institution. As a community college in the CUNY system, Hostos offers a wide variety of courses for university transfer, general education, preparation for careers, and enrichment. Contractual teaching load for full time faculty is 27 contact hours (9 courses) per year. Some evening or weekend teaching may be required. Summer teaching is optional. Opportunities for additional funding for research activities, curricular and pedagogical innovations, and research travel are available through CUNY-wide competitive grants and external funding. Full-time faculty must also share responsibility for committee and department assignments including administrative, supervisory and other functions and, in the case of professorial ranks, must demonstrate progress in the scholarship and research of their area(s) of expertise.
