Check out what we're working on! The Coaching Unit has a number of special initiatives that are currently in progress:

<u>Citibank Grant</u>

In collaboration with Citibank, students with an assigned coach who pay for one summer course will be able to take a second course payable by Hostos. In addition, these students will commit to three financial coaching sessions in an effort to increase financial literacy on campus.
