Based on Ariel Dorfman poem and story about two children who play "waiting for the enemy" under the shadow of a dictatorship. This film translates this situation of terror to undocumented immigrant children hiding in a safehouse somewhere in the New South.

Twelve Cuban's with dwarfism talk to the camera about sex, love, work and dignity, comprising a realistic and revealing portrait of the city of Havana, as seen from a slightly different perspective than usual.
