Joint Certificate Program Professional Development Credit for Educators

Hostos Community College and Universidad Autónoma de Santo Domingo present a summer professional development program in New York City and the Dominican Republic for educators and education students, as well as other professionals interested in learning about the Dominican-American experience and the language, history, education and culture of the Dominican Republic. Content will focus on the educational systems of both countries.

Study at Hostos Community College and in the Caribbean at Universidad Autónoma de Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic and Instituto de Educación Superior Salome Ureña de Henriquez. Visit the National Palace of the Dominican Republic, as well heritage sites and historic districts in different cities. Also visit public schools in the Dominican Republic.

DOE professionals will receive professional development hours credited towards their NYS license certification and a certificate of completion of the program from Universidad Autónoma de Santo Domingo and from Hostos Community College of The City University of New York.

- Teachers or other education professional, post graduate and undergraduate student in education
- Professionals serving communities of Dominican/Caribbean/Latino nationality or ancestry.
- Willingness to work on group projects both in the Dominican Republic and upon return.
- Interest in education, public policy and cross-cultural understanding.
- Knowledge of Spanish is helpful, but not required.
