Licensed Practical Nursing (LPN) Certificate (Developmental Need)

LPN Minimum Passing Grade Requirements

- A minimum grade of B- is required in ENG 110 and MAT 120*
- A minimum grade of C is required in PSY 101, BIO 230, BIO 240, PSY 110, BLS 150 or SOC 101 and BIO 310**
- Students with more than one "D" or "F" grade in pre-requisite courses will not be selected for the LPN clinical program

Students seeking to transition from LPN to the A.A.S. R.N. must:

- Successfully complete an accredited LPN program
- Pass the NCLEX-PN Examination
- Successfully complete all RN pre-requisite courses

Students who meet all of the stated requirements should contact the faculty coordinator for the LPN to RN Pipeline Program to have their transcript evaluated for eligibility and to schedule the NLN Mobility I Profile Examination. Acceptance into the RN clinical program is competitive and based on students' academic record, work history and NLN score.

Students with the highest composite scores are selected for admission into the LPN clinical program.
