We are initiating discussion at the seminar concerning the structure and curriculum of the Math Ed major program of our department. The motivation for the discussion is the discovery that school districts around the country are introducing teachers' scripted materials and lesson plans, which cause the development of habits contradictory to the facilitation of creativity among the teachers, and therefore students. The introductory discussions on the subject reveal divided opinion among the mathematics educators, some strongly criticize them, some see them as the necessary help. Our colleagues from the Education Department are invited to the Seminar to participate in the brain storming on the subject. Everyone, especially our adjuncts who are also teachers are invited to express their opinions.
