They will be able to review legacy applications and determine how best to support or enhance them. The individual will ensure best practices are followed in the security architecture for solutions and be a valuable team player in helping the department deliver the next generation of applications to the campus community.

Additional responsibilities include the following:

- Responsible for Sharepoint and Mobile application development

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. High School Diploma, G.E.D., or equivalent
2. An equivalent of seven years of experience post-high school that can be met by one of the following: seven years of full-time work experience in a computer or technology related position; an Associate's degree plus five years of full-time work experience in a computer or technology-related position; a Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution plus three years of full-time work experience in a computer or technology-related position
3. Demonstrated English Language proficiency
4. A Motor Vehicle Driver's license, valid in New York State, may be required for some, but not all positions.

- Possess a strong background in front-end UI/UX (HTML5/CSS/javascript/AJAX/jquery, etc.), backend/server side technologies (Python/.NET/PHP/Java, etc.), RDBMS integration (MS SQL), REST/SOAP/web services/API's, SDLC and modern programming languages
- Experience in the following: developing RDBMS connected applications using .NET or Java on IIS and authenticating against a directory service such as LDAP/Active Directory, installing, configuring and maintaining MS SQL Server databases in a high-availability environment, creating web pages with HTML 5.0 and CSS following responsive design practices
- Experience utilizing API's and Web Services, collecting end-user requirements and translating those into an application/system design document following SDLC best practices, knowledge of SharePoint Framework 2013 or later development, JavaScript, Angular JS, React or other similar technology
- Experience designing, implementing and troubleshooting optimized applications and databases and strong familiarity with Microsoft Server platforms including administering IIS application pools and security.
- Experience in Project Management/Agile Methodology, Mobile app development for iOS and Android
- Knowledge of code versioning tools (e.g. Git)
- Familiarity with legacy programming platforms e.g. ASP, ASP.net, AR/VR development, R and Data Science, OWASP
